Ron is celebrating 50 years at Stepinac! **This milestone will be commemorated on May 8th here at the school.** Call 914.946.4800 x282 for details & ticket information. In his honor the school is raising money to build a new Physics Lab & update the labs he helped renovate 15 years ago. As a tribute to Ron, **an anonymous alumnus will match all gifts dollar for dollar up to \$100,000.** We hope you will join us for the festivities to honor Ron & also help us meet this goal.

Ron Tedesco's history with Stepinac began in 1953, his freshman year. By graduation in 1957, he established himself as a scholar. He tied for 1st overall at graduation, won the Math, Science, German Medals & tied for the English Medal. He served in the US Army Reserves from 1957 to 1965.

In 1962, Ron earned his BS in Physics from Manhattan College, graduating 1st in his class from the School of Arts & Sciences. In 1964, he earned his MS from Fordham University & did additional graduate work in Education at NYU, Fordham, & Long Island University leading to a Certificate in School Administration & Supervision.

He began teaching at Stepinac in 1964. From 1967 through 1989 he chaired the Science Department while teaching Physics & a college level course in Electronics. Ron then served as Headmaster from 1989 to 1999. While at Stepinac, he also taught as an Adjunct Professor of Physics & Math at Marymount College, Tarrytown, from 1967 to 1990. In 1999 Ron retired from education but not from Stepinac. From 2000 to 2014, he worked as Director of Alumni Affairs & the Annual Fund.

He currently serves as Secretary to Stepinac's Foundation Board & Stepinac's Alumni Association. Ron is also involved in his own community. In 1988 he became a member of the Tarrytown Planning Board. We wish Ron many happy & healthy years in his retirement.
